## Provisioning Checklist

To provision Bayalink Liberty in your organization, here are a few key things that must be taken into consideration and carried out:

- ✓ Once your contract is signed and you have received physical shipment from Bayalink (or a certified Bayalink reseller), you should obtain the .alx and .cod files so you can push the Liberty handheld client to the devices you want to be Liberty enabled
- ✓ Next you must register the PIN numbers of the devices you want to be Liberty enabled.
- ✓ Once the devices are registered with the Bayalink license server, you can set your BES policies with respect to the Liberty application and push the policy to the handheld
- ✓ Finally make sure the Liberty key version matches the Liberty handheld version.
- ✓ If you are deploying Liberty keys, make sure the users understand they have to do a one-time Bluetooth pairing from the BlackBerry to the Liberty Key.
- ✓ For any PC or Laptop where the Liberty viewer is to be run, a Bayalink Liberty key USB driver must be installed. Most versions of Windows require local admin rights to install a driver. For convenience, the driver is located on the Liberty key in the drivers folder.
- ✓ To assist your users, the Getting Started Guide is located on the Liberty key in the docs folder in pdf format.

## Tools and Utilities

After purchase, contact Bayalink to get access to the Enterprise Provisioning Portal for deployments of 50 users or more. This utility will allow you to mass copy PIN numbers extracted from your BES Server into the Bayalink Liberty licensing portal. These PIN numbers are the devices you have licensed for Liberty.
